

Caregiver Definition :

Non-paid adult family member who Takes care of another person who can no longer care for themselves. Either the caregiver or care recipient must be 55+ years of age.

This includes **Grandparents** age 55+ or older who are raising their grandchildren and have Legal Custody or Guardianship.

Relief Respite Caregiver Definition:

Family or friend who is approved by Elder Services to perform Relief Respite Care for the Primary Family Caregiver to have a break from their responsibilities for self care..

Voucher/Stipend:

Will be paid to the Relief Respite Caregiver for up to 10 hours per month while funding is available.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ Relief Respite Caregiver must be pre-approved by Elder Services.
- ◆ Approved Background Check from Oneida Tribe of Indians
- ◆ Initial Assessment to determine need.
- ◆ Fill out required forms once approved:
 - *Voucher Application
 - *Provider Agreement
 - *Voucher Invoice
- Recipient must reside within Oneida Reservation boundaries
- ◆ **Basic Services provided by the Oneida Elder Services Native American Family Caregiver (NAFCG) Program:**
- ◆ **Information & Assistance** regarding services available to the

- ◆ **Loan Closet** items are available for caregivers to borrow at no charge to assist them in caring for recipient.
- ◆ **Respite care** is provided by NAFCG so the primary caregiver can have a break from their caregiving responsibilities during regular working hours only.
- ◆ **Monthly Alzheimer's/Caregiver Support Group** for primary caregivers.
- ◆ **"Powerful Tools for Caregivers"** workshops.
- ◆ **Conduct an Assessment** to determine need.
