ORDER DISMISSING PETITIONER'S COMPLAINT

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

Background

Petitioner filed a civil action to reinstate his business on the Oneida vendors list based on Indian Preference. A hearing was held on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. The Respondents motioned for dismissal based on failure to serve the Tribe's Secretary's Office pursuant to section 153.5-6 of the Oneida Judiciary Rules of Civil Procedure.

Findings of Fact

The court finds as follows:

1. The Court has Territorial, subject matter and personal jurisdiction.
2. On July 19, 2016, a hearing was held.
3. The Tribe, or the officers, committees, commissions, boards, or any other department or division of the Tribe is a party to this case.
 - a. The Indian Preference Office is a department or division of the Tribe.
4. The Petitioner failed to serve the Tribe's Secretary's Office in accordance with section 153.5-6 of the Oneida Judiciary Rules of Civil Procedure.

Order

The court enters the following order:

The Respondent's motion to dismiss is hereby granted and case #16-TC-032 is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
