ORDER DISMISSING PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Denice E. Beans presiding.

Background

On September 13, 2016, Petitioner filed a small claims civil action to obtain a judgment for amounts of money transferred from Respondent's Capital One card to Petitioner's Priceline/BarcalyCard, money Respondent borrowed for a camping trip with his son, money borrowed to pay for a real estate class and test, half of a family cell phone plan from September 2015-April 2016, and disconnection fees in May 2016. The Petitioner claims that the Respondent paid back a total of \$300.00 leaving a balance owed to the Petitioner of \$2,266.08.

Findings of Fact

The court finds as follows:

On October 13, 2016, a hearing was held. The Petitioner failed to appear, plead, or prosecute.

Order

The court enters the following order:

Pursuant to 153.29-3 of the Oneida Judiciary Rules of Civil Procedure case #16-TC-064 is dismissed without prejudice.
