FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding.

BACKGROUND

The Court received a petition for a Temporary Restraining Order to stay the eviction and the changing of the locks on Anthony & Marla Webster-Bodway's residence located at W344 Cornelius Circle, Oneida, Wisconsin 54155, by the Oneida Housing Authority (OHA). The Temporary Restraining Order was granted and a hearing was scheduled for February 10, 2017. On February 20, 2017, the Parties filed a stipulation.

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. The Court has jurisdiction pursuant to Chapter 150 of the Oneida Code of Laws.
2. The Court accepted the petition for a temporary restraining order and placed a stay on the eviction procedure at the residence of Anthony & Marla Webster-Bodway located at W344 Cornelius Circle, Oneida, Wisconsin 54155.
3. The OHA pursued the termination of Petitioner's Mutual Help and Occupancy Agreement due to unpaid rent and utilities.
4. At the hearing, the Petitioners and Respondent entered into a stipulation.
5. The Court finds the stipulation reasonable.

ORDER

The stipulation is approved. The stipulation and repayment agreement between Anthony & Marla Webster-Bodway and OHA dated February 20, 2017 is attached and incorporated into this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
