FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

BACKGROUND

The Court received a petition for a Temporary Restraining Order to stay the eviction and the changing of the locks on Jacquelyn Ann Mitchell Young's residence located at 1253 Chief Hill Dr. Green Bay, Wisconsin 54313, by the Oneida Housing Authority (OHA). The Temporary Restraining Order was granted and a hearing was held on Thursday, February 9, 2017.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Court has jurisdiction pursuant to Chapter 150 of the Oneida Code of Laws.
2. The Court accepted the petition for a temporary restraining order and placed a stay on the eviction procedure at the residence of Jacquelyn Ann Mitchell Young located at 1253 Chief Hill Dr. Green Bay, Wisconsin 54313.
3. The OHA pursued the termination of Petitioner's Rental Agreement due to unpaid rent, electric, gas, water and sewer bills.
4. During the hearing, the Petitioner and Respondent entered into a stipulation.
5. The Court finds the stipulation reasonable.

ORDER

The stipulation is approved. The stipulation between Jacquelyn Ann Mitchell Young and OHA dated February 10, 2017 is attached and incorporated into this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
