2. Due diligence:
  - Personal service and service by certified mail was satisfied.
  - Personal service and service by certified mail was not satisfied.
3. The request to serve by publication in the Tribal newspaper or in a newspaper of general circulation in the area of the party's last known address is:
  - GRANTED.
    - a. The party publishing notice is responsible for service costs.
    - b. The "Legal Notice" shall be published at least two (2) times within a thirty (30) day period.
    - c. The two (2) notices shall be published at least ten (10) days before the hearing.
    - d. Copies of the two (2) published notices and an affidavit of service shall be filed with the Court as proof of service.
