FINAL ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

A citation was issued to the Defendant on September 12, 2018 alleging Livestock At Large under 304.9-2 of the Oneida Code of Laws. The Defendant is not required to appear in court for Livestock At Large citation. A pre-trial hearing was held on October 18, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. The Defendant did not appear at the hearing. The court deemed service on the Defendant as improper and re-scheduled the hearing to December 20, 2018. The parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement with the court on October 26, 2018.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. On September 12, 2018, Oneida Police Department filed a Citation for violation of O.C. 304.9-2 Livestock At Large.
3. The Defendant admitted to proper service in this action.
4. The parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement on October 26, 2018 dismissing this action.


ORDER
