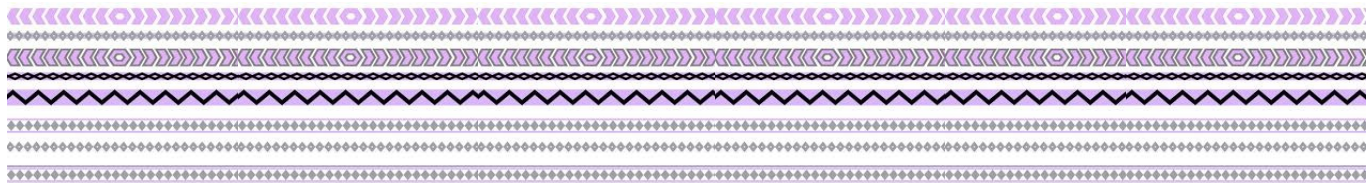
We provide for all families a caring and nurturing environment through the incorporation of the Oneida Culture and the use of developmentally appropriate practices that supports the individual development of all children.

The Administration Staff has received new tablets so that we can go paperless as much as possible. However, some areas still require hard copies.



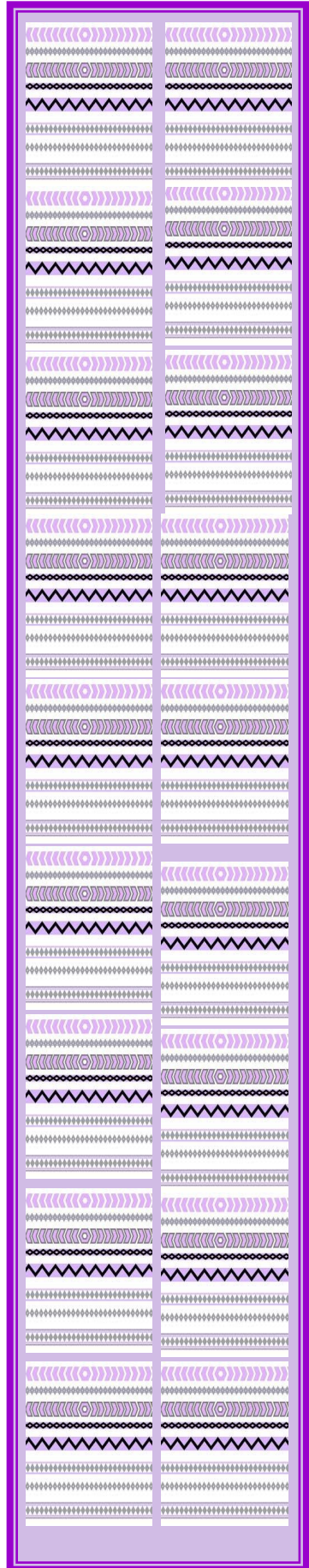

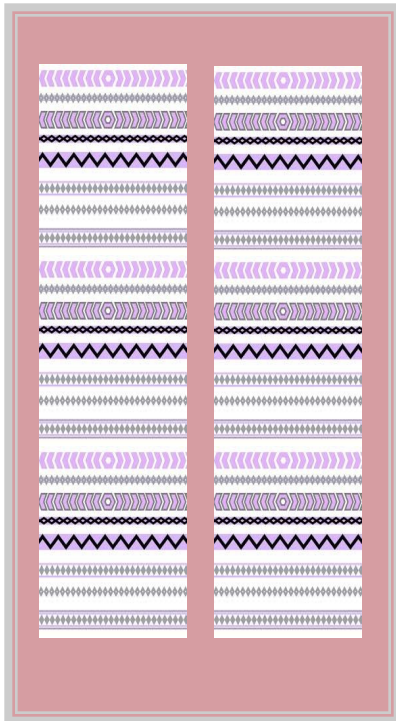
Head Lice at Daycare

There are 3 stages to lice - egg, nymph and adult. Infection occurs when an adult climbs from one head to another, or contact with an infested item, such as comb, hat, brush, pillow, car seat or back of chair. Unless all of the eggs, nymphs and adults are killed, they will continue to infest. (Lice Clinics of America).

Symptoms make take 2-3 weeks to appear. If lice are in the eyelashes or other areas of your body, you need to see your doctor for evaluation and treatment.

At ARCC our policy states that immediate exclusion will not occur with Lice or nits. Exclusion for treatment of active lice infestations may be delayed until the end of the day. Since exclusion is unlikely to reduce the spread of disease, the most important reason for exclusion is the ability of the child to participate in activities and the staff to care for the child.
