Article 111 Governing Body

- Sec. 2. Length of residence may be added.
- Sec. 6. Add "by a favorable vote of five."

Article V Reverendum

- Sec. 3. Omit "of a quorum"

Article VI

- Sec. 1. (f) Change "advancement of the people to "advancement of the membership"
