R E S O L U T I O N 1-3-77-B

Whereas, tribal organizations are eligible to apply for contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to plan, conduct, and administer all or parts of Bureau authorized programs, under authority of Public Law 93-638;

Whereas, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis, the governing body, has determined that it wishes to exercise the contracting option;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved That;

- The scope of the contract is to plan, conduct and administer the financial assistance for the Johnson O'Malley programs.
- The tribal chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto
- 3 The authorities granted herein shall be effective untillsuch time as the Business Committee takes further action by resolution.
- 4 The Oneida Business Committee shall review the contract and any amendments thereto before execution.
- 5. The proposed date for start of the contract is Aug. 1977 and shall continue fo Sept. 30, 1979.
