


Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians contracts for AVT and DE monies for Employment Assistance, and

WHEREAS, In November, the Employment Assistance Office experienced a \$25,764.00 budget cut for Fiscal Year 1977 services, (From 102,000.00 Fiscal Year 1976 to \$76,236.00 Fiscal Year 1977)

WHEREAS, Present funding is not adequate to meet Oneida's needs for Fiscal Year 1977 DE services and AVT students; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- A. The Oneida Tribe of Indians requests additional funding through any sources available to include:
 - 1. Year-end leftover monies.
 - 2. New legislation passed to develop additional funding.
 - 3. Emergency or any other form of funding.
