Request for BIA Assistance and Determination to Acquire

- WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and
- WHEREAS, Article IV (f) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available Tribalfunds for public purposes, and
- HEREAS, funds are presently available for the purchase of the following parcels of land:

The West Fifteen (15) rods of the North Sixteen (16) rods of Lot Twenty-two (22), Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twenty-four (24) North of Range Twenty (20) East, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, excepting therefrom the East 134 feet and that part used for highway purposes;

And

That part of Lots Twenty-two (22) and Twenty-three (23), Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twenty-four (24) North of Range Twenty (20) East, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot Twenty-two (22) and running thence South Sixteen (16) rods to the place of beginning, thence continuing South Eighty (80) rods; thence East Twenty (20) rods; thence North Eighty (80) rods; thence West Twenty (20) rods to the place of beginning.

and

EAS, the owner(s of record of said properties are:

Mamie Benson Gerald Benson

and

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the Oneida Housing Authority, and Oneida Tribal Planning Office have determined that the above-mentioned parcels are acceptable for the use of public assisted housing

- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee has determined that the acquisition of the above parcels are in the best interest of the Oneida Tribe, and that the Oneida Tribal Planning Office be authorized to initiate and effectuate the real property acquisition process, based upon the established guidelines and procedures, and utilizing the funds allocated for this purpose, and
- E IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Office to review the abstract of these properties to determine clear title and to make the necessary arrangements in conjunction with the Oneida Tribal Planning Office to facilitate placing this property into trust status at the time of closing.
