#### REGARDING PARDON OF BRUCE DICKENSON

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV., Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee Was presented a Pardon Petition on behalf of BRUCE DICKENSON, and
- WHEREAS,** the requirements of the Oneida Pardon Ordinance and Oneida Pardon Procedures Policy have been fulfilled, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee hereby recommends DENYING the pardon petition of BRUCE DICKENSON, Petitioner.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby:

√ **DENIES** the Pardon of BRUCE DICKENSON, Petitioner and notifies the Petitioner that he/she may request another pardon after one (1) year from the date of certification of this document.
