RESOLUTION 2-6-79-A

- WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin administers the Relief to Needy Indian Persons Program (RNIP), and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. conducts a local RNIP Program, under contract, with the State of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, such Program is applicable to only those Indian persons residing on land specifically identified as U.S. Trust land, and
- WHEREAS, the majority of Oneida Tribal members do not reside on Trust land, but rather reside on fee patented land within the 1838 Reservation boundaries, and
- WHEREAS, Indian persons residing on such lands may also be needy persons,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Oneida Business Committee request Sharon Metz or some other legislator to sponsor an amendment to the statute that regulates the RNIP Program so that the Program can be applied to all needy Indian people within the original exterior reservation boundaries of those Tribes who have reservations in Wisconsin and to include language that would be applicable to those Tribes who do not have reservations.
