Resolution No. 2-17-76

WHEREAS, the Field Office position assigned to Oneida was frozen in Mid 1975,

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Field Office served the Stockbridge Muncee; Winnebago, Oneida and sometimes served the Michigan Tribes,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is in a location with an urban area in the immediate vicinity, where housing, good schools, and all types of transportation available,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe can offer beau-coup office space on their reservation
- WHEREAS, before 93-638, finances and positions were provided the Minneapolis Area Office to establish an Agency on the Oneida Reservation, which would serve Forrest County Potawatomi, Mole Lake, Stockbridge-Muncee, Winnebago and Oneida,
- WHEREAS, this agreement remains unchanged and is in the Central office in Washington, D.C. awaiting the Secretary of Interior's signature.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has a legal right to this previous agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that any BIA positions or services that are to be established are hereby designated to be situated on the Oneida Reservation, to serve the Oneidas, Winnebagos, Stockbridge-Muncee and Menominee Tribes.
