

## OMEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN

## RESOLUTION /

WHEREAS, The Oceida Tribe of Indians of Misconsin, have over many years participated in an ensuity payment pursuant to Treaty of Movember 11, 1794, (7 Stat. AA) with the Six Metions of New York, and

WHENEAS, the last annuity payment was authorized August 25, 1962, and shares from the last payment remain unclaimed, and

WEREAS, by Act of September 22, 1961 (FL 87-283, 75 Stat. 584) provision is made for the restoration to Indian Tribes of unclaimed per capita and other individual payments of tribal trust funds, and

WARREAS, all unclaimed shares meet the requirement for restoration to the tribe by being unclaimed for a period of six years from date of administrative directive to make the payment,

HOW THEREFORE BE IT SESOLVED. That the Bureau of Indian Affairs petition the Secretary of the Interior to imitiate action to cause the unclaimed annuity funds to be restored to tribal memorahip of the Gaeida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
