RESOLUTION NO. 3-4-83-B

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated by the Oneida General Tribal Council the responsibility of administering governmental programs on behalf and for the health, education and welfare benefits of its members; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Health Center was established by the Oneida Tribe to provide comprehensive health services for the Oneida Tribal members including dental care; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has determined that good dental hygiene will be improved by increasing flouride levels at homes in Site II from 0.6 parts per million to 1.2 parts per million; and,
- WHEREAS, The water supplied by the tribally operated system to other homes on the Oneida Reservation is adequate.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Oneida Business Committee directs the Oneida Health Center to increase the level of flouride in the water supply to Site II to provide adequate dental protection being provided to other tribal homes.
