RESOLUTION NO. 3-5-84-A

WHEREAS: The Oneida Tribe has assumed the responsibility to implement the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978; and,

WHEREAS: The Act requires that the Tribe vest authority over child custody proceedings in a Tribal court or any other administrative body; and,

WHEREAS: The Oneida Tribe is without a Tribal Court.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

That the Oneida Child Protective Board be the administrative body vested with authority over child custody proceedings; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the following Tribal member be appointed to the Oneida Child Protective Board for a period of two years, commencing on the date this resolution is approved.
