

RESOLUTION NO. 68-15

WHEREAS, "That part of Claim 134 of section Four (4), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Claim 134 and running North four (4) chains to the center of the Seymour Road, thence South eighty-five degrees (85°) East Fourteen (14) chains to intersection of 1/2 section line, thence West 13.25 chains to the place of beginning, containing 2.65 acres, subject to right-of-way of old Seymour road," was conveyed by deed to the United States of America in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, recorded on June 6, 1940, with life use reserved by Richard Metoxen in his offer to sell lands to the United States, dated September 30, 1938, and

WHEREAS, after the death of Richard Metoxen, a Grant of Tribal Land Assignment was issued on all the above-described property by the Oneida Executive Committee to Harvey S. Metoxen on March 23, 1957, for homesite and garden purposes, and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 1962, Harvey S. Metoxen issued a document, approved by the Oneida Executive Committee, granting to his sister, Patricia Metoxen Farms, a lifetime lease on a portion of the subject property, and

WHEREAS, this lifetime lease issued by Harvey S. Metoxen and the Oneida Executive Committee was never approved by the Secretary of Interior as required by Section 5(b) of the Corporate Charter of the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Patricia Metoxen Farms, an Oneida Indian, and her husband, Lester Farms, a non-Indian, have constructed permanent improvements and make their residence on a portion of the subject property, having no binding contract therefor, and

WHEREAS, Harvey S. Metoxen does not make his permanent residence on the subject property,

BE IT THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in special session assembled, that the land assignment of Harvey S. Metoxen is hereby cancelled and that due notice be provided, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of an application, the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency, Ashland, Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to prepare and approve a residential lease in favor of Mr. and Mrs. Lester Farms, for the subject property, excluding the easternmost .65 acres, for a 50-year period at one-half of the fair annual rental in accordance with Departmental Regulations 25 CFR 131, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Executive Committee are hereby authorized to sign the lease for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N
