## RESOLUTION # 03-08-91-C

- WHEREAS: the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has adopted a resolution to request Farmer's Home Administration funds for the Oneida Sewer Project, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has empowered the Oneida Utility Commission to act as the primary agent for securing sewer and water for the "Oneida Village" area of the Oneida Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Utility Commission has negotiated with FmHA to secure funds to construct sewer and water facilities, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Utility Commission and the Oneida Tribe have advertised for bids for Phase I of the Oneida Sewer project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe, upon recommendation of the Oneida Utility Commission, follow the recommendation of McMahon & Associates Engineering Firm and award the contract for construction of Phase I Sewer and Water to Dorner Stahl of Luxemburg, Wisconsin.
