

## **RESOLUTION # 03-12-97A**

Oneida Parks and Recreation, Oneida Gang Task Force, Oneida Healthworks Grant Application

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS. the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the priority of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain and build a solid educational foundation by addressing human needs of all members throughout the circle of life, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe, through the Oneida Parks and Recreation Area, and the Department of Justice-Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, Ounce of Prevention Program would like to implement programs that will enhance or expand youth-led activities that prevent substance use among youth.

WHEREAS, that Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family will be strengthened by promoting the overall cultural, educational and prevention needs of the Oneida Community for the next seven generations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in cooperation with the Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, Ounce of Prevention Program authorizes and submits this grant application for the on-going and collaborative efforts of the Oneida Parks and Recreation Area, Oneida Gang Task Force, Oneida Healthworks and other prevention programs.
