## RESOLUTION # 03-12-99D M & I Bank Resolution

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to lease from M&I First National Leasing Corp. (the "Lessor) coin wrappers, Jetsorts, Jetscans, and related equipment for use at Oneida Bingo and Casino (the "Equipment"), and

WHEREAS, there have been prepared and submitted to this Business Committee the following documents (collectively the "Financing Documents") relating to the transaction:

- 1. A Lease of Personal Property, together with Schedule A describing the Equipment, and Addendum A1, providing for an option to purchase the Equipment and early termination procedures;
- 2. A "Waiver of Sovereign Immunity; Jurisdiction," providing for a waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity for purposes of enforcing the provisions of the Financing Documents in federal or state courts in Wisconsin;
- 3. UCC forms evincing Lessor's interest in the Equipment;
- 4. An Insurance Certificate certifying that the Tribe has insured the Equipment in accordance with Lessor's requirements;
- 5. A Lessee Financial Certificate making representations to Lessor regarding the Tribe's assets and liabilities, payment of obligations, pending litigation, required tax returns, and related information.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe acknowledges that the Financing Documents contain a waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity for purposes of their enforcement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Financing Documents, in the forms attached hereto, are hereby approved by the Oneida Business Committee, and the Oneida Business Committee hereby authorizes the execution of said Financing Documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Chief Financial Officer, or any one of them, of the Tribe be and hereby are authorized and empowered on behalf of the Tribe to execute, acknowledge, and deliver on behalf of the Tribe, and in its name the Financing Documents and any and all amendments, supplements, modifications or riders thereto.
