ONEIDA TRIBAL BUSINESS COMMITTEE MINUTES SPECIAL MEETING MARCH 13, 1975

Meeting called to order 7:35 p.m. by Vice-Chairman, Irene Moore. A quorum was present. Norbert Hill was appointed to take the minutes.

Vice-Chairman brought forward the request for a meeting with the Airport people on March 20, 1975. A discussion followed in regard to what it would take to be ready for the meeting. It was pointed out that it would be well to have an attorney. A motion was made by Wendell McLester and seconded by Eva Danforth to direct the Land Committee and the 701 planners to meet and come up with recommendations before the meeting with the Airport people.

A discussion followed with Bob Christjohn, the new Tribal Administrator as to the scope of the job for which he has been hired. All phases of the position were touched on by the Committee and Mr. Moeller.

A letter from the Green Bay Public Schools was read and discussed. A motion was made by Norbert Hill to table the letter indefinitely; it was seconded by Wendell McLester. Motion carried.

There was further discussion on the new position. Monday, March 24, 1975 was set for a starting date. The layout of things for the Administrator to do were - agenda - ONAP savings report - list of program due dates - and a budget for the Administrator position.

The Industrial Developer's position was discussed and it was suggested that the Administrator review the minutes of January 4, 1975 - General Tribal Council meeting and the basis for pay.

Meeting adjourned 9:25 p.m.
