## Resolution # 03-14-07 B

"Repealing Resolution 8-02-06-T REGARDING PARDON OF BARBARA LIGHTFOOT and Adopting Corrective Resolution REGARDING PARDON OF BARBARA LIGHTFOOT"

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV., Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee has presented a Pardon Petition on behalf of <u>Barbara Lightfoot</u>, and
- WHEREAS, the requirements of the Oneida Pardon Ordinance and Oneida Pardon Procedures Policy have been fulfilled, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee hereby recommends <u>DENYING</u> the pardon petition of <u>Barbara Lightfoot</u>, Petitioner.
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee took action by adopting Resolution # 8-02-06-T which accepted the recommendation of the Oneida Pardon Screening Committee and denied the pardon; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution # 8-02-06-T was not clear in regards to its action requiring that Resolution # 8-02-06-T be corrected, which is the intent of the Oneida Business Committee in adopting this resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby:

 $\checkmark$  **DENIES** the Pardon of <u>Barbara Lightfoot</u>, Petitioner and notifies the Petitioner that he/she may request another pardon after one (1) year from the date of August 2, 2006.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that resolution 8-02-06-T is hereby repealed.
