RESOLUTION NO. 4-15-83-A

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has by its governing body, the General Tribal Council, delegated to the Oneida Business Committee its governing powers under Article IV, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution subject to its review; and,

WHEREAS, One of these powers is the authority to enter into contracts; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians desires to protect the health of the Reservation residents and the natural environment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorizes the filing of applications for point source water pollution abatement grants; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That PURCELL POWLESS will serve as the authorized representative in connection with the application.
