

RESOLUTION NO. 74-4-19

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has contracted with PHS-IHS for FY 73-74 in the amount of \$81,755, and

- WHEREAS, such funds are designated by same contract to meet specific health needs of Indian persons, and
- WHEREAS, an excess of \$3,000 is projected for the current fiscal year by the Oneida Health Committee, and
- WHEREAS, members of the Winnebago Tribe residing in Wood County are not serviced by the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribal contract, and
- WHEREAS, such Winnebago Tribal members have great need for such services and,
- HEREAS, the transfer of \$3,000 from the Oneida contract to assist other Indian people in Wisconsin will not deprive Oneida persons of any health services now available,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee agrees to release \$3,000 of the FY 73-74 contract back to I.H.S. and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such amount be utilized to supplement existing contract between I.H.S. and Wood County Winnebago Community and otherwise meet the health needs of those persons.
