- MHEREAS, the members of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Misconsin are in dire need of standard housing, and,
- WHEREAS, Representatives of the Public Housing Administration and the Eureau have appeared before the Tribal Council of the Oneida Band to explain the Public Housing Administration's program for making low-rent and self-help housing available to eligible Indian tribes, and,
- WHUREAS, in order to participate in the program of the Public Housing Administration, be it,
- RESOLVED, by this General Tribal Council in session assembled, that Tribal Ordinance No. 1 is hereby adopted which charters a public corporation which is and hereafter will be known as, "The Oneida Housing Authority"; that this action is taken pursuant to provisions contained in the Constitution and By-Laws of Oneide Tribe of Indians of Misconsin, approved on November 14, 1936, particularly to authority vested in the General Tribal Council by Article 1V, Section 1(a) (c) C (0).
