RESOLUTION NO. 4-22-92-B

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the property known as the "Airview" parcel described as:

PARCEL NO. VA-140-7 2.65 Acres

A part of Private Claim 21, West Side of Fox River, in the Village (formerly Town) of Ashwaubenon, Brown County, Wisconsin.

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 92, Province Subdivision First Addition, being the intersection of the North line of said Private Claim 21 West Side of Fox River, with the East line of Shady Lane; thence South 64 degrees 19 minutes East along the South line of said subdivision, 270.82 feet to the West line of Babcock Road; thence South 24 degrees 44 minutes West along said West line, 135.02 feet; thence South 64 degrees 19 minutes East, 70.01 feet to the East line of said road and the point of beginning; thence continuing South 64 degrees 19 minutes East, 285.67 feet; thence South 26 degrees 00 minutes West, 398.42 feet more or less; to a point on the North line of Airport Drive; thence North 64 degrees 00 minutes West along said line, 227.50 feet more or less to a point on the Easterly line of a vision corner at the intersection of Babcock Road and Airport Drive; thence North 18 degrees 44 minutes West along Easterly vision corner at the intersection of Babcock Road and Airport Drive, 77.41 feet; thence North 26 degrees 32 minutes East along the East line of Babcock Road, 122.71 feet; thence North 24 degrees 44 minutes East along said East line, 218.30 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL NO. VA-140-2-1 1.35 Acres

That part of Private Claim 21 West lying Easterly of Babcock Road and described in 989 Record 543 of Brown County Records except 76 Jacket 264 Image 42 and 43 of Brown County Records, located in the Village of Ashwaubenon, Brown County, Wisconsin.

PARCEL NO. VA-140-2-2 4.00 Acres

That part of Private Claim 21 West lying Easterly of Babcock Road and described in 989 Record 544 of Brown County Records, located in the Village of Ashwaubenon, Brown County, Wisconsin.


WHEREAS, The above described parcel is requested in trust status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide economic development endeavors of the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
