## RESOLUTION April 30, 1965

- WHEREAS, the present Constitution and by-laws of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin provides that the same may be amended by a majority vote of qualified voters of the Tribe voting at an election called for that purpose by the Secretary of the Interior, provided that at least 30% of those entitled to vote shall vote in such election.
- RESOLVED, that the Chairman shall forthwith petition the Secretary of the Interior to promptly call an election for the purpose of amending the present Constitution and by-laws of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in the form submitted with this resolution.
