### Intertribal Agriculture Council/Made By American Indians Trademark/Oneida Nation Farms & Agricultural Center

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain, and promote self-sufficiency and self reliance by providing food and support services for Oneida Tribal members and others in the community who cannot afford it, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has established the Oneida Nation Farms and Agricultural Center in an effort to provide a means for self-sufficiency, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has made many human and financial resources available and supports the license and use of the "Made by American Indians" trademark for the promotion of agricultural or other Indian made products which have been produced and/or processed by enrolled members of federally recognized Tribe, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin-Oneida Nation Farm and Agricultural Center authorizes and submits this trademark application to the Intertribal Agriculture Council for the trademark use of "Made by American Indians".
