Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States was made possible.

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
### RESOLUTION NO. 5-0405-R Fee to Trust Resolution for the Former Nachreiner Property

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:  
Nachreiner Property at 470 Airport Road, Oneida, WI
- WHEREAS,** the parcel is described as follows: See attached Legal Description  
Tax Parcel Nos. HB-1344 and HB-1347
- WHEREAS,** the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing site for Tribal Offices, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

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**Former Nachreiner Property  
Resolution No. 5-04-05-R**

The following land is located in Sections 2 and 3, Township 23 North, Range 19 East of the 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Village of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin.

Part of Indian Claims 157 & 159, Section 2 and 3, T23N, R19E, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, Fourth Principal Meridian, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the northerly most corner of Indian Claim 157; thence N55°23'22"W, 481.73 feet to the North line of Section 3, T23N-R19E; thence N89°58'54"E, 132.00 feet along said North line of the Northwest corner of Section 2, T23N-R19E; thence S89°40'35"E, 591.83 feet along the North line of said Section 2; thence S37°04'52"W 408.79 feet to the North line of Indian Claim 157; thence S55°23'22"E, 176.15 feet along the north line of said Indian Claim 157, to the easterly most corner of said Indian Claim 157; thence S44°49'47"W, 709.81 feet along an east line of said Indian Claim 157; thence S0°35'47"W 32.52 feet along an east line of said Indian Claim 157; thence S88°38'50"W, 172.00 feet; thence S0°35'47"W 354.75 feet to the north right-of-way of S.T.H. "172", also known as Airport Drive; thence E88°42'19"W 207.37 feet along said right-of-way; thence N85°50'07"W, 153.01 feet along said right-of-way; thence 71.68 feet along said right-of-way being the arc of a 1372.39 foot radius curve to the right whose long chord bears N89°47'54"W 71.67 feet; thence N68°07'33"W, 76.86 feet along said right-of-way; thence 208.73 feet along said right-of-way being the arc of a 1183.24 foot radius curve to the right whose long chord bears N82°52'12"W, 208.46 feet to a west line of said Indian Claim 157; thence N37°08'08"E, 534.14 feet along said West line; thence N56°04'29"E, 1009.76 feet along a west line of said Indian Claim 157 to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 575,023 square feet/15.52 acres, more or less.
