Motion made by Eva Danforth to approve Treasurer report, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Secretary read letter from State Welfare Department inquiring if Loretta Adams, daughter of Irvin Adams is on Oneida roll. Treasurer said she would check roll and let them know. Letter also read from Mr. Riley in regards to Sherman Skenandore's permit to cut wood to sell. However Julius Danforth said Sherman had not asked him to sign permit for him so council assumed he no longer wanted it.

The following birth certificates were submitted for enrollment (6). Ronald Joseph Metoxen, Simon William DeCoteau (transfer from Chippewa band), Donald Charles Metoxen, Donald Herbert Salveson, Debra Jo Metoxen, Gary Stephen Waubanascum.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve the 6 certificates, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

A land release was presented to the council from Van Roy Thomas, also a new application for same parcel of land presented for Robert Homes.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve the release and the application for Robert Thomas, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Leander Danforth was at meeting to inquire if his loan is still available which he applied for in April, 1961.

Motion was made by Eva Danforth to pay \$50.00 toward bldg. material as a down payment if he could make an agreement with Norman Schaumann. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to authorize treasurer to pay Norman Schaumann \$95.00 on Lester Schuylers loan. Seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

Motion made by Eva Danforth to adjourn. Seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.
