RESOLUTION # 5-11-94 J

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
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- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Council, to manage all the economic affairs and enterprises of the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: Smits Property

A parcel of land located in part of Indians Claims One Hundred Thirty seven (137), One Hundred Thirty-eight (138), One Hundred Forty-eight (148), One Hundred Forty-nine (149) and One Hundred Fifty (150), Also the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4), in Section Three (3), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, in the Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Indian Claim 137; thence N 0° 14' 08" W, 250.42 feet along the easterly line of Volume 659 Records, page 611; thence N 61° 41' 03" W, 220.00 feet along the westerly line of Volume 620 Records, page 420, to the southerly line of Indian Claim 137, and centerline of Florist Drive; thence N 61° 41' 57" W, 1545.20 feet along said Indian Claim line and said centerline; thence N 26° 04' 16" E, 396.19 feet along said Indian Claim line and said centerline; thence N 26° 04' 16" E, 396.19 feet along the easterly right-of-way being the arc of a 598.69 foot radius curve to the right whose long chord bears N 38° 14' 16" E, 252.36 feet; thence N 50° 24' 16" E, 190.25 feet along said right-of-way; thence 43.30 feet along said right-of-way, being the arc of a 471.24 foot radius curve to the left whose long chord bears N 47° 46' 18" E 43.29 feet; thence S 73° 29' 00" E, 253.41 feet along the southerly line of Jacket 4533, Image 34; thence N 15° 03' 31" E, 285.09 feet along the easterly line of said Jacket 4533, Image 34, to the southerly line of Indian Claim 148; thence N 73° 29' 00" W, 1086.10 feet along said Indian Claim line and the northerly line of said Jacket 4533, Image 34, to the easterly right-of-way of C. T. H. "E", also known as Freedom Road; thence N 21° 11' 34" E, 168.18 feet along said right-of-way; thence S 68° 52' 09" E, 449.88 feet along said right-of-way; S 68° 52' 09" E, 330.00 feet along the southerly line of Jacket 13675, Image 21; thence N 28° 38' 02" E, 245.00 feet along the easterly line of said Jacket 13675, Image 21; thence S 75° 30' 00" E, 530.36 feet along a line between Indian Claims 147 and 148; thence N 34° 16' 24" E, 326.98 feet along said line to the southwesterly corner of Indian Claim 149; thence N 51° 55' 25" E, 164.94 feet along a line between Indian Claims 147 and 149; thence N 61° 21' 51" E, 317.49 feet along a line between Indian Claims 151 and 149, to the southwesterly corner of Indian Claim 150; thence N 32° 22' 31" E, 912.83 feet along a line between Indian Claims 150 and 151, to the southerly right-of-way of S.T.H. "172", also known as Airport Drive; thence S 82° 01' 34" E, 84.00 feet along said right-of-way; thence 41.16 feet along said right-of-way being the arc of a 1482.40 foot radius curve to the left whose long chord bears S 79° 14' 17" E, 41.16 feet; thence S 32° 40' 12" W, 271.93 feet along the intended westerly line of Jacket 12857, Image 25, as occupied; thence S 63° 50' 36" E, 131.22 feet along the intended southerly line of said Jacket 12857, Image 35, as occupied; thence N 29° 03' 38" E, 309.54 feet along the intended easterly line of said Jacket 12857, Image 35, as occupied, to the southerly right-of-way of S.T.H. "172", also known as Airport Drive; thence 177.52 feet along said right-of-way, being the arc of a 1482.40 foot radius curve to the left whose long chord bears S 88° 11' 51" E, 177.42 feet along said right-of-way; thence S 45° 39' 07" E, 55.53 feet along said right-of-way; thence S 0° 19' 28" W, 2549.31 feet along the westerly right-of-way of Overland Road; S 89° 33' 05" W, 287.03 feet along the northerly line of Jacket 8144, Image 24; thence S 0° 19' 28" W, 403.04 feet along

the westerly line of said Jacket 8144, Image 24; thence N 89° 33' 05" E, 287.03 feet along the southerly line of said Jackey 8144, Image 24, to the westerly right-of-way of Overland Road; thence S 0°19' 28" W, 916.96 feet along said westerly right-of-way to the south line of Section 3, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, abeing the centerline of Florist Drive; thence S 89° 33' 19" W, 1281.64 feet along said Section line and said centerline to the place of beginning.



WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certified that the local property taxes will be paid up to Trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians
