

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, Tanya R. Hill, a tribal members, have made application for a long-term lease for residential purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the tribal land selection is described as follows:

Lot 9, Block 2, Cora House Subdivision, located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, Township 24 North, Range 19 East, 4th P.M., Brown County, Wisconsin, containing 1.0 acres, more less.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
