Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the Colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States, was made possible.


RESOLUTION # 5-12-93-B

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, under Article III, Section 4, states the General Tribal Council shall meet on the first Monday of January and July of every year, and
- WHEREAS, the first Monday, July 5, 1993 is a holiday and the same day as the Oneida Pow Wow, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee believes that the first Tuesday, July 6, 1993 is a more appropriate date to hold the semi-annual meeting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee hereby sets Tuesday, July 6, 1993 as the official day to hold the semi-annual General Tribal Council meeting.
