RESOLUTION 5-21-84-B

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has delagated the responsibility of the Oneida Constitution to the Oneida Business Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has placed a high priority on Physical Education and athletic excellence, and
- WHEREAS, Oneida athletes have distinguished themselves in many sports and historically competed with the greatest Indian athletes in the world, and
- WHEREAS, the Jim Thorpe Memorial Games will be held in Los Angeles California from July 21 to July 28, 1984 to commemorate Jim Thorpe, Sac and Fox Indian, and the two Olympic gold medals he won in 1912, and
- WHEREAS, the Great Jim Thorpe "Longest Run" will leave the Onandaga Nation on May 28, 1984 to run across the United States through fourteen (14) states, including Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the "Longest Run" will pass through Wisconsin on June 9, 10 and 11, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, Oneida runners will meet the "Longest Run" national team at the Wisconsin border and run into Madison.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the honor and tribute to the physical and mental fitness that Jim Thorpe showed throughout his athletic career the week of June 9 through June 16, 1984 shall be declared JIM THORPE WEEK, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Oneidas are encouraged to support the "Longest Run" and the Jim Thorpe Memorial Games in Los Angeles in July 21 to July 28, 1984.
