
RESOLUTION # 5-23-01-D
Development of Tribal Court Planning Grant
U.S. Department of Justice

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that the overall goal of the Oneida Nation is to protect, maintain and improve the standard of living and the environment in which the Oneida people live, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has created the Oneida Appeals Commission as the highest level of appellate review within the Oneida Judicial System and to hear original cases that have no specified hearing forum, and
- WHEREAS,** the mission of the Oneida Appeals Commission is to "...serve to enhance and protect the rights and sovereignty of our Nation and its citizens. Jurisdiction shall extend over all persons and cases in law and equity under the laws and constitution of the Oneida Nation", and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby authorizes and submits a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for a Development of Tribal Court Planning Grant.
