RESOLUTION NO. 75-6-2-3

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin supports the activities of the American Indian National Bank and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee is the responsible fiscal agent for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin's Bank accounts for all contracts, grants and / or gifts afforded the Oneida people by Federal and State agencies and / or charitable organizations and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians presently has \$1,426,768.33 trust monies that is administrated by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the BIA has placed said monies in a 30 Day account with the Industrial National Bank, Providence, Rhode Island.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorize the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs to deposit the remaining portion of the 15% monies from Docket #75 Oneida, New York emigrant claim to the highest rate of interest available and / or \$100,000 with the American Indian National Bank meets or exceeds the highest interest bid received by the BIA. In addition the American Indian National Bank will have to satisfy the BIA regulation pertaining to trust investments of this nature.

## CERTIFICATION
