

Resolution No. <u>6-3-9J-B</u>

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the United States Housing Act of 1937 in regard to public housing and the 1961 amendment recognizing Indian Housing Authorities does not address the present comprehensive housing needs of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the present regulations pertaining to Indian Housing and Indian Housing Authorities diminishes self-sufficiency, self-governance, and sovereignty of the Indian Nations, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Nations hold the ultimate authority for the <u>health</u>, <u>safety and welfare</u> of their membership.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin recognizes the need for greater flexibility in housing in regard to our unique culture, our economic and geographic status, and multiple needs versus HUD low income housing, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wholly supports H.R. 4027, the Self-Governance Demonstration Project model in block granting housing funds to Tribes, and
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That in the passage of H.R. 4027, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby authorizes an application for participation in the demonstration program.
