BE IT RESOLVED that the Annuity monies accumulated in the Treasury Department since 1964 be and hereby are requested for dispersement by the B.I.A. on a per capita basis to all of the enrolled members of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action does not preclude a previous Resolution to draw up and execute a workable program that is satisfactory to the Tribe.
