## RESOLUTION 74-6-5

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, in a special General Tribal Council meeting on April 28, 1974, adopted a resolution to retain \$1,000,000 of the Trust money from Claim Docket #75 for developmental purposes,
- WHEREAS, as Resolution 74-4-28 specified that a Trust Committee be set up from the General Tribal Council (All Tribal members)
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Trust Committee be elected on July 6, 1974 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., for one year,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Trust Committee consist of 9 (nine) members, one of whom will be a member of and represent the Oneida Tribal Business Committee, that the Tribal Chairman at all times will be an ex-officio (not-Voting) member of the Trust Committee,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Trust Committee will organize an advisory Committee to include, but not be limited to an accountant, a banker, an attorney and an economist,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Trust Committee meet the following criteria:
  - A. Have experience in administration
  - B. Willing to work on a gratis basis, until such time that funds are available for expenses
  - C. Be knowledgeable about financial matters
  - D. Be bondable
  - E. Have a good personal credit rating
  - F. Must be a member of the Oneida Tribe
  - G. Must be available for all Trust Committee meetings
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interested candidates should submit their resume' to the Business Committee not later than June 30, 1974.

## CERTIFICATION
