## R E S O L U T I O N 6-15-81G

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Business Committee is the duly authorized and delegated representative of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and;
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee is charged under the Tribal Constitution with the duty of enhancing the health, security and general welfare of the Oneida Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, Tribal members who reside on Poplar Lane agree that Poplar Lane be improved and that the Oneida Tribe waive the process for a survey to be done and also to waive any damages that might incur, and;
- WHEREAS, The Town of Oneida will do improvement of Poplar Land and will black-top the road, and;
- WHEREAS, All residents who live on Poplar Lane agree and request for such improvement.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee does hereby request such waiver, so that immediate improvement will commence
