Secretary reported that she had a letter in reply to the treaty of 1794 from the assistant Attorney General's office where by they advised the tribe that the acceptance of accumulated annuity would have no adverse effect on our pending claims.

Secretary was advised by council to inform Mr. Riley of date and place of Tribal meeting. Council discussed the exchange of land referred to as lot X on Hwy 54 and 6 acres share of James Shenandoah on former Daniel Sk. Allotment.

Vice Chairman was advised to call the lawyers to confirm their visit here for the tribal meeting and also to call Press Gazette and have them advertise meeting and also mention the caucus on July 8 at C.C.C. at 2 p.m. along with the business of the exchange of land.

Discussion on conventions and points to be brought out.

Motion by Althea Schuyler to adjourn, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.
