RESOLUTION No. 6-25-82-A

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has assumed the responsibility to implement the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, and,

WHEREAS, The act required that the Tribe vest authority over child custody proceedings in a Tribal Court or any other administrative body, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is without a Tribal Court

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Oneida Child Protective Board be the administrative body vested with authority over child custody proceedings, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

That the following three Tribal members be appointed to the Child Protective Board for a period of one year, commencing on the date this resolution is approved.
