

Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.



RESOLUTION # 6-26-92-13

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee, in the interest of continuing to provide injury prevention activities to Tribal members and their families, and
- WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service has funds available to provide for injury prevention activities related to the impaired driver.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin will submit a proposal for non-recurring alcohol program funds to be added to the current P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Indian Health Service, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribal Chairman or his delegate; and the Oneida Social Services Manager, are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
