

RESOLUTION # 6.27-97A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain, and promote self-sufficiency and self reliance by providing housing for those Oneida Tribal members who cannot afford it, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe through the Oneida Housing Development Program and with collaboration of the U.S. Dept of Interior; Housing Improvement Program (HIP), and with Oneida Community input, would like to have an accurate and updated inventory of current HIP needs, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family will be strengthened by promoting the values of our Oneida Identity by providing housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin-Oneida Housing Development Department, authorizes and submits this updated tribal inventory of housing needs to receive funding monies for the 1998 Housing Improvement Program for the purpose of securing affordable, well built housing improvements for those who cannot financially provide it for themselves.
