Resolution BC 06-30-08-A *Repeal of Oneida Housing Ordinance*

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America;
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** on April 20, 1963, the Oneida Housing Ordinance was enacted pursuant to Oneida law; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee desires to revise the structure of the Oneida Housing Authority created pursuant to the Oneida Housing Ordinance by repealing the Oneida Housing Ordinance and bringing the Oneida Housing Authority within the organizational structure of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS,** a public hearing on the repeal of the Housing Ordinance was held on April 15, 2008.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee hereby repeals the Oneida Housing Ordinance and directs that the Oneida Housing Authority shall be placed as a program of the Tribe.

CERTIFICATION
