
## Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin

## BC Resolution # <u>07-01-98-A</u> Interim Lead Program Resolution

WHEREAS.

the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS,

the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of the Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS,

the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of the Constitution of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS,

the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Council, and

WHEREAS,

the Environmental Protection Agency has granted Indian Tribes the opportunity to seek authority to administer their own training and certification programs for lead-based activities and

WHEREAS,

the Oneida Tribe desires to adopt standards regarding a comprehensive lead program to protect employees and tribal members from lead poisoning, and

WHEREAS,

it is in the best interest of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to participate in an interim of compliance and enforcement program of Lead Based Activities for a period of three years,

WHEREAS.

the Oneida Tribe has a limited time in which to file an application for a lead program which does not allow for submission of the ordinance to Public Hearing, and

WHEREAS,

the failure to submit a Lead Program application could result in loss of ability to develop such a program under federal guidelines in the future and/or application of state regulation of this type of program within the Oneida Reservation, and NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Lead Program Ordinance is hereby adopted on an emergency basis for six months during which time a Public Hearing shall be scheduled, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Industrial Hygiene Program of Oneida Environmental, Health and Safety is hereby delegated the responsibility to implement this law and develop the required policies as well as necessary training for full implementation of this law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin
desires to participate in an Interim Indian Tribal lead-based paint compliance and enforcement
program of the federal register 745.327 for a three year periodto
