Meeting called to order by Chairman Julius Danforth.

Secretary gave report of June meeting. Motion made by Irene Moore to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Motion made by Eva Danforth to approved treasurer's report, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Leroy Cornelius was at meeting to inquire if he could plant his brother Earl Cornelius' land while he is in the armed services.

Motion was made by Althea Schuyler to give Leroy permission to work this land on shares with Earl during Earl's absence. Seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Mrs. Irvin Adams was at meeting to advise committee that they want to keep their house and land assignment. She said that they intend to move back there when they can fix it up. Secretary turned in a check for \$7.00 on land fees for Gordon McLester III.

Leroy Cornelius inquired if he could enroll Adrian Charles on tribal roll. Council advised him to send \$1 plus the birth certificate to treasurer and she would present it at the next meeting.
