Oneida Business Committee Resolution # BC-<u>705</u>95-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has both the responsibility and the duty to provide programs and support for the elders within the Oneida Nation, and
- WHEREAS, consistent with Article IV of the Oneida Tribal Constitution, the Oneida Business Committee may delegate its authority and responsibilities to subordinate Tribal agencies, officials, and organizations, subject to the Committee's continued right to review the exercise of such authority, and
- WHEREAS, Oneida Nation Social Services is the subordinate organization best able to provide necessary programs and support to the elders within the Oneida Nation, and
- WHEREAS, Oneida Nation Social Services is under the direction of the Governmental Services Division of the Administrative branch of the Oneida Nation,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby formally delegates to the Social Services Program, within the Governmental Services Division, the authority necessary for the administration of all Oneida Tribal programs for the elderly, and the responsibility ti assure that all such programs are administered in the best interests of the elders of the Oneida Nation.
